## Monroe School Board Workshop

MONROE HIGH SCHOOL LIBRARY

The Monroe School District Board of Directors has determined that the facilities of the school district are in need of significant improvement and have been working towards that goal.

They have engaged an architectural firm to develop a facility plan and community outreach program. They and their engineers have developed a list of improvements for all school facilities and a projected cost of each project.

The district has also collected cost per thousand data for the community to help develop a bond for community approval in November. The November election will require 50.1% approval to pass.

The district has written and received a grant from the state for \$1,500,000.00 for improvements at Monroe Grade School to make sure the building is structurally safe in case of a seismic event.

The district qualifies for \$4,000,000.00 in funding from the State of Oregon if it passes a bond the same size or larger than the \$4,000,000.00.

The district can qualify for another \$1,500,000.00 for seismic upgrades for Monroe High School IF the district has funds (the bond) to complete these project costs. The projected cost for seismic upgrades to MHS exceed the available \$1,500,000.00.

The school board values the opinions of it's staff and community members. You are invited to join them on **April 26, 2016 at 5:00 in the High School Library** to review the recommended projects from the architect and engineering firms, prioritize the list, and recommend a bond amount for the November election.

While the final decision rests with the elected board of directors, they want to open the conversation to all who are impacted by these decisions.

You are invited to join this conversation next Tuesday.
