

Monroe School District #1J  
Special Board Meeting  
Held at Superintendent's Office  
June 1, 2010

The Board meeting was opened by Chair Nancy Burnett at 7:00 P.M.

Present were Board Members: Nancy Burnett, Tony Stroda, Bob Warden and Tim Warden.

Also Present: Superintendent Randall Crowson and Grade School Principal Brenda Goracke.

Board Member Mylrea Estell arrived at 7:07 P.M.

The meeting was moved to Executive Session under ORS 192.660(2)(a) to consider the employment of a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent and as per ORS 192.660(2)(d) to conduct deliberations with persons designated by the governing body to carry on labor negotiations as per ORS 192.660(2)(d)

The meeting was returned to open session at 8:55 P.M.

There was a discussion on the lack of funding to end this school year and lack of adequate budget for 2010-2011. There was also a concern about the years after 2010-2011. The Board expressed regret that they need to make a drastic move in order to ensure the viability of Monroe School District into the near future.

Tony Stroda moved that Randy Crowson, the Superintendent, notify the Monroe Teachers Association that we are going to be doing a layoff as covered in Article 18 of the current agreement between the Monroe Teachers Association and the Monroe School District #1J. He stated the layoff would entail the elimination of the music program and therefore would be the layoff of the music teacher. He further stated that the Kindergarten would be reduced to pre 2009-2010 levels and would again become a .5 position. Robert Warden seconded. Aye 5 – Nay 0.
