The Monroe School District Board of Directors would like to announce a change of administrative leadership for our schools. Russ Pickett has resigned and effective February 24, 2017, Randy Crowson will step into the role of Interim Superintendent. He will work in this capacity through June 30, 2017 and then work as a consultant through the 2017-18 school year. Effective July 1, Bill Crowson will take on the role as the district's Interim Superintendent. Kathi Holvey continues her work as the Grade School Principal serving over 300 students. The Board feels this to be the best and most seamless transition for our students.

The School Board is in the beginning stages of working with Gerding Builders, the newly hired Construction Manager to schedule the first of the bond projects at Monroe Grade School.

The deadline to accept Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) applications has been extended to March 6, 2017.
